## **Token Presence**

No sooner had the concept of the Non-Fungible Token (NFT) arrived on the contemporary-art scene than Artision started pondering how it might be used to digitally protect works of design. Step forward designer Nicola Gallizia, who this year presented his 'Viaggio in Italia' collection (shown above: wood-inlay sideboard, £21,000 approx) with the Milan company. Each piece was given an NFT, acting as a digital passport; only the building or object linked to the certificate will be considered authentic. Blockchain technology ensures that this minting cannot be altered. Because the NFT also covers the creator's inspiration, materials and techniques, Gallizia hopes it will preserve
